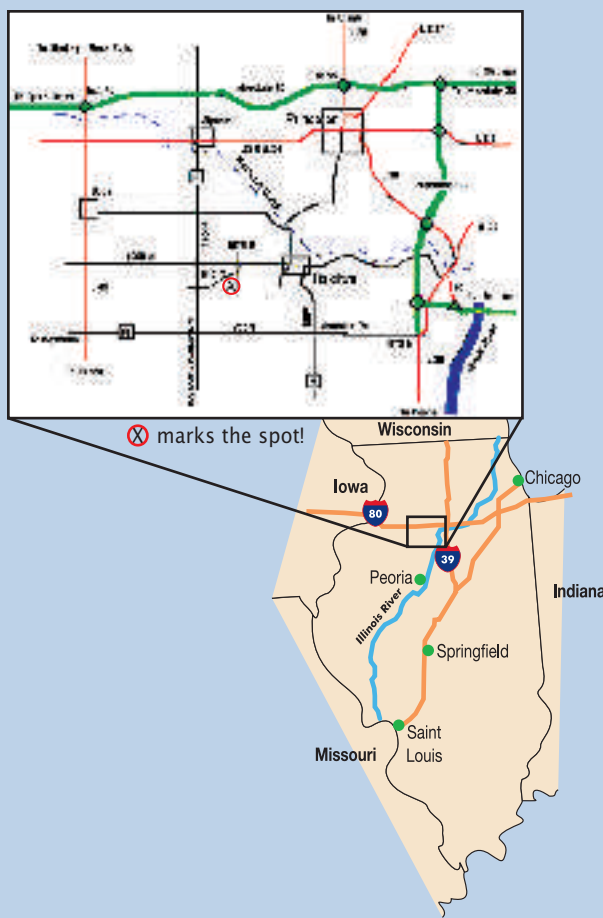
Safety is the number one priority on each segment of Menno Haven's Course. Each group is led and supervised by a certified Menno Haven Facilitator, trained and experienced in Adventure Education program safety and procedures. If you are interested in becoming a Facilitator, please contact Menno Haven and register for our yearly Facilitator Workshop. Restrictions are listed below:

- Facilitator must be at least 18 years of age
- Facilitator must complete Menno Haven's extensive training program.
- Certification is invalid if there is more than one year's lapse in facilitating a group.

Note: Menno Haven may recognize certification of Facilitators from other approved courses upon thorough discussion and observation of the Facilitator by a Menno Haven Facilitator Instructor.

Safety, Communication, Teamwork and Growth.

Teamwork

Cooperative Activities are clearly defined physical and/or mental tasks given to a group. The goal of each is to create interaction. These activities are the least difficult, least risky, and require minimal equipment and props.

Initiatives Course (Low Ropes) are a series of challenges at ground level (0-12') that can only be accomplished by a group. They require participants to work together to solve a series of problems. The attempts and results are creative, fun, and helpful in building group cooperation, communication, trust, and more.

Safety

Cooperative Activities

High Ropes Course



"We see [growth] at the course and all year long. Students are less likely to say "I can't," but instead say, "I can try." They learn that they can push themselves just a little harder than they thought and take one step more out of their comfort zone." ~ Elementary School Teacher

High Ropes Course is a series of ropes, logs, and cables constructed in such a manner as to create a series of challenging elements 15' - 40' off the ground amid a collection of beautiful red and white oak trees. Participants challenge themselves to go beyond previously set self limitations, gain confidence through their efforts, and learn the importance of encouraging one another.

Initiatives Course

Indoor Climbing Wall

Indoor Climbing Wall is a 64' wide textured surface with artificial rocks constructed in such a manner as to create multi-levels of challenging climbs 0'-23' off the ground. Participants challenge themselves to go as high as they can. While others are climbing, challenge yourself to transverse the entire length of the wall.

Growth

Requirements for the Adventure Education program:

Communication

Each group, lead by a trained facilitator, will have a unique experience through our Adventure Education program. The use of individual elements requires your group to work as a team to solve problems. You will focus on group goals such as Trust,



Leadership, Proper Planning, Following and Effective Listening. Your experience will conclude with a group discussion, processing what the group as well as each



individual person learned. We shape the discussion and learning according to the group's experience and goals. Interwoven in the Adventure Education program are opportunities, if requested, for application of spiritual principles for everyday living.

Challenge by Choice

At Menno Haven our motto is "Challenge by Choice." While we will encourage you to go beyond your comfort zone, we believe that no participant should ever be forced to do anything that they choose not to do. Come experience how Adventure Education can develop a team spirit within your church, school, social agency and even in the corporate arena.
