


Happy Solar Anniversary to us. On April 18, 2019 we installed solar panels on the roof of Deer Run. The solar panels have generated 16.88 MWh in the past year!! Several wonderful things have happened to provide even more financial savings for us. We merged the individual meters on the Deer Run Staff home into one allowing the power generated by the panels to cover the power usage of the entire building. Our power company changed it's "banking power" policy so that instead of banking quarterly it now banks yearly. The means that if the solar panels generate more power than we use, we are given a credit that doesn't expire until the end of the calendar year (not at the end of the quarter). We also received a grant which covered the cost of the solar panels as well as most of the cost of the new metal roof!! Praise the Lord for the timing of this improvement!

Summer Camp 2020 Update:

It is with great sadness that we will not be running our scheduled 2020 Menno Haven programmed summer camps this year. Hopefully you have already heard about this in a previous letter or on our social media. We grieve for our campers, summer staffers, and parents. This is not easy for any of us. We want to find a way that we can help.
