May has been a whirlwind of a month. It started with the knowledge that we would not be running our scheduled 2020 summer camp programs. We turned our attention to planning and preparing the Haven At Home Boxes and planning events to help us stay in touch with you, our constituents, and provide a taste of Menno Haven since you couldn't come here.



We had two fundraisers in May to help provide funding for the Haven at Home Boxes. The first was a Sunday Cool T-shirt Fundraiser. **We sold 105 shirts!!** If you purchased one of these shirts - thank you! Not only did you get a really great shirt but you also helped us to raise over \$600 towards the Haven at Home boxes and future summer programming! Orders for the Haven At Home Boxes closed on June 2nd with **109 boxes ordered.** They will be sent out in June to campers from Illinois, Colorado, Florida, Missouri, Kentucky, and California. WOW!

currently helping to put together the activities, videos, and resources in the Haven at Home Boxes as well as helping with various program, office, and maintenance related tasks.




