It was a great day to be outside and do wood splitting and stacking, finish cleaning up the large Oak tree that fell in the West Village during the derecho, removing autumn olive (an invasive species) in one of our prairie plantings, reorganizing the Roundtop wood shed by splitting the north side into two sections to provide better organization for seasoned firewood and adding a door to the west end for easier access. Some volunteers also were able to do some deep cleaning in the dorm rooms. It was a great to share the day with friends!



While all of our campers and guests have enjoyed the patio, this fall in particular it was a significant blessing to be able to provide a lovely large space for outdoor eating. The weather was so nice the first week of November that the guests used the patio to eat all of their meals. Who would have thought that could have happened in November?!?!
