- 1) One family found <u>several hammocks</u> at their house in storage and wondered if we could use them. Yes, please! Guests, campers, and summer staff love these additions around camp.
- 2) Another friend who owns a countertop business made and <u>donated new bathroom counters / sinks</u> to replace the pedestal sinks in the campground bathhouse (see photo above).



Fall Work Day Volunteers - We had a great group of friends who came on a beautiful day in October to help in various ways at camp. There were two big projects for the day: (1) forest restoration / removal of invasive species between the Lodge and the Lake and (2) taking down 15 dying / unhealthy trees along 1575 East St (the road along the main drive) and cleaning up all the debris.

We also had friends <u>winterizing flower beds</u>, <u>transplanting perennials</u>, <u>helping in the kitchen</u>, <u>splitting firewood</u>, <u>retrofitting metal crates</u> to hold firewood, and <u>deep cleaning of dining hall chairs and upper Lakeview Lodge chairs</u>.

3) A youth group who volunteered this summer saw that we could use <u>more picnic tables</u>. So they are making them at home and will bring them to Menno Haven when they are completed.
