Menno Haven and the Fellowship 55 attendees were blessed by the presence of Jan Gleysteen, a Mennonite historian from Holland. Jan's input included slideshows (yes, with actual slides, not Powerpoint) of various topics including Christian and Anabaptist history, Menno Simon's life, the Hutterites, and Holiday's in

> Europe. Jan also shared about his life during World War II and the Nazi Occupation. The war came to life as Jan explained his family's experience with hunger during those years and the different tactics that the Nazis used to convince the Jews to go to the camps and showed everyone real newspaper articles, pictures, and flyers from the time. Around 20 people were present throughout the week to

hear Jan's presentations.

Other activities included the traditional hayrack ride, campfire with kettle corn, a hymn sing, and service projects. Wednesday night Les and Gwen Gustafson-Zook held a concert in Lakeview Lodge. They held the attention of almost 60 people as they dazzled us with their voices and instruments, many of them homemade.


