For the second year in a row Menno Haven hosted three Winter Retreats in January and this year all of the winter retreats felt like winter outside! The first weekend Menno

Haven put on its second annual <u>Young Adult Winter Retreat</u> and this year invited participants to stay the entire weekend! Randall Koehler of Metamora Mennonite Church led the worship sessions and worked through *The Gospel in John* with the retreat participants. An "enjoyable weekend of worship, games, God, relaxation, and laughter" was had by all of the participants!





The second weekend shifted to <u>High School Winter</u> <u>Retreat</u> and welcomed Bryan Miller of Roanoke Mennonite Church as the speaker. Bryan talked with the youth about how we believe the Biblical narrative is for instruction in salvation and training in righteousness. College presentations were set up from three Mennonite Colleges giving students a chance to think about post high school. The students enjoyed "seeing all of my friends and worshiping together" and "reuniting with friends and meeting new ones."

The third weekend Menno Haven hosted the <u>Junior High Winter</u> <u>Retreat</u> and Ashley Litwiller of Arthur Mennonite Church as the speaker. Ashley spoke about what it means to be a part of God's ream while talking about her topic #WeNotMe and sharing stories from her life. The students enjoyed the tournaments and being able to ce skate this year.
