




## Summer Wages

\*All summer staff will receive room & board. Paid staff positions will receive a weekly wage based on the information below.\*

**BASE WAGES:** The weekly wage for college age summer staff is \$130/week and the wage for high school age summer staff is \$110/week.

\*Paid positions only available for ages 16 and up. Under 16? Ask about available volunteer positions to see how volunteering can prepare you for a job in the future.

**ALL RETURNING SUMMER STAFF** may earn an additional \$10/week for each year paid on summer staff here at Menno Haven. Up to \$20/week additional.



## Summer Schedule

**Rally Day:** May 25, A fundraiser open house for Menno Haven to kick off the camping year!

**Staff Orientation Week:** June 14-19, learn what it means to become a summer camp missionary, get certified in belaying & first aid-CPR and more!

**Cottontail:** June 21-24, 4 day intro camp for grades 3-5

**Junior High - Trailblazer:** June 28-July 3, traditional week of camp for Jr High campers

**Junior High - Adventure:** June 28-July 3, spend a full week out on our Adventure Education Course.

**Blue Jay:** July 5-10, full week camp for grades 4-6

**High School - Cardinal:** July 12-17, traditional week of camp for High School campers

**High School - Wilderness:** July 12-17, a week of camping in tents including a canoe trip. Got a hammock? Bring it!
